Where do we start?

- Alberta Law i.e. Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA)
- The Alberta legislation you are incorporated under may dictate how you collect and use personal information (e.g. Societies Act s. 36 and 36.1).
- Depending on your organization's activities, other Alberta laws may be applicable.
- Contracts or funding agreements may require you to use or collect personal information in a certain way.
- Depending on the jurisdiction of your operations, different country's or province's laws may apply.
- Your organization may already have policies and procedures in place!

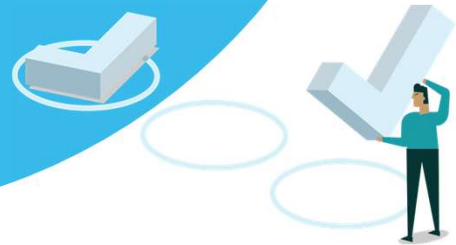

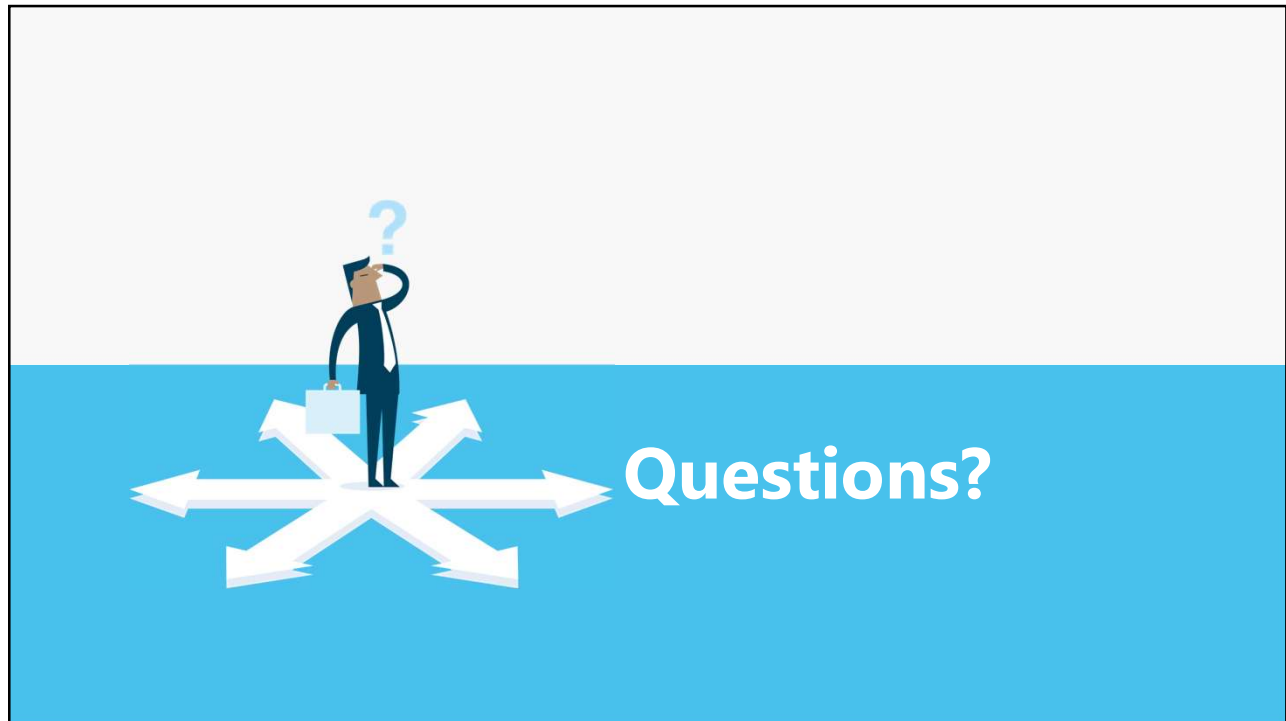
